Sample Itinerary

Day One: Grand DeTour Historic Site & Sandy Pine Elk Farm (I-88 & HWY 40)

- AM: Arrival at the *John Deere Historic Site* (Admission) in Grand Detour, IL. John Deere Historic Site is where you will tour the home that John Deere built, the archaeological dig and experience the blacksmith creating iron work designs right in front of you and visit the gift shop.
- Travel to the Quad Cities and check into your hotel, the Radisson Moline
- Enjoy the evening on your own with options to include visiting an area casino, enjoying a scenic walk along the riverfront or experience a variety of restaurant options within a 3 block radius of the hotel.

Day Two: Touring the Quad Cities

- Complimentary breakfast at the Radisson on John Deere Commons
- Morning tour of a John Deere Factory (as available)
- Then choose one or more from the following:
 - *Deere Wiman & Butterworth Mansions* (Admission): two majestic mansions built in the late 1800s by Charles Deere, son of John Deere. The three-story Victorian Deere-Wiman home built in 1872 for himself and his wife. In 1892, Charles Deere built the Butterworth Home as a wedding gift for his daughter and son-in-law, Katherine & William Butterworth.
 - John Deere World Headquarters (Free) Exhibit Area
- Lunch on the John Deere Commons (Free) where you will find, within walking distance, several restaurants to choose from as well as shopping.
- Guided tour of the John Deere Pavilion (Free)
- Return to the Radisson Moline – directly across the street to freshen up
- Dinner at *Circa '21 Dinner Playhouse* (Admission) originally a vaudeville and silent movie house, among one of the most popular and unique of its day.
