## Sample Itinerary

### Day One

- Visit the *John Deere Historic Site* (Admission) in Grand Detour, IL. John Deere Historic Site is where you will tour the home that John Deere built, the archaeological dig and experience the blacksmith creating iron work designs right in front of you and visit the gift shop. - Visit *Cinnamon Ridge Farm* (Admission) Tour the working farm including a new hog confinement viewing area, operation, cattle, soybean and dairy. Contact: 563-505-1652
- Check into the Radisson on John Deere Commons
- Discover the Mississippi River with a wonderful dinner cruise on the *Celebration Belle River Cruises* (Admission). Contact: 309-762-1952

### Day Two

- Complimentary breakfast at the Radisson on John Deere Commons
- Tour the John Deere Harvester Works in East Moline, IL (Free). Get up close to combine production lines, enjoy the exhibits and informational tour guides, while you ride comfortably on a tour cart with audio headsets for each rider. Contact John Deere Guest Services: 1-800-765-9588
- Return to the hotel to freshen up and enjoy lunch at the on-site restaurant, TGI Friday's or a variety of other options within walking distance.
- Then choose one or more from the following:
  - *Deere Wiman & Butterworth Mansions* (Admission): two majestic mansions built in the late 1800s by Charles Deere, son of John Deere. The three-story Victorian Deere-Wiman home built in 1872 for himself and his wife. In 1892, Charles Deere built the Butterworth Home as a wedding gift for his daughter and son-in-law, Katherine & William Butterworth. Contact: 309-765-7971
  - John Deere World Headquarters (Free) Exhibit Area
- Return to the Radisson Moline – to get ready for dinner
- Dinner at *Circa '21 Dinner Playhouse* (Admission) originally a vaudeville and silent movie house, among one of the most popular and unique of its day. Performances available Wed (2), Fri, Sat and Sun. Contact: 309-786-2667
